Writing with Adverbs

- * A word that describes a verb is an ADVERB. Some adverbs answer the question “how?”
- * The dog barked LOUDLY.
- * The tiger waits PATIENTLY.
- * The girl sits QUIETLY.

Adverbs that tell Where and When.

- * Some adverbs answer the question “Where?”
- * It has beautiful pictures **INSIDE**.

- * Some adverbs answer the question “When?”
- * Let’s travel to the beach **TODAY**.

Preposition or Adverb?!

Adverbs describe the verb.

He ran outside.

Prepositions describe the noun.

He was outside the classroom.
