- ◆ Could use a writing frame to structure sections
- ◆ May include images

Grammar and Sentences

- ◆ Use **coordinating conjunctions** to link two main ideas,
Badgers sleep in the day and look for food at night.
- ◆ Use **subordinating conjunctions** in the middle of sentences,
Badgers can dig well because they have sharp claws
- ◆ Use **noun phrases** which inform,
sharp claws, black fur
- ◆ Use **commas** to separate items in a list,
You will need flour, eggs, sugar and water.
- ◆ Use **exclamation sentences** where appropriate,
What a fantastic time we all had!
