In Music we will be focussing on:

- Improvisation and composition of music for a range of purposes.

In maths we will be focussing on:

- Revision of calculation using adding, subtraction, multiplication and division
- Fractions including decimals and percentages
- Algebra
- Imperial and metric measurement
- Perimeter, Area and Volume
- Ratio and Proportion



In RE we will be focussing on:

- **Islam:** What is the best way FOR A Muslim to show commitment to God?
- **Christianity:** Salvation: What difference does the resurrection make for Christians?

In Science we will be focussing on:

- Identifying how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways, and that adaptation may lead to evolution
- Describing how living things are classified into broad group according to common observable characteristics
- Recording data and results of increasing complexity using scientific diagrams and labels, classification keys, tables and graphs.

During our topic we will be focussing on:

- Identifying the position and significance of latitude, longitude, the Equator, Northern and Southern Hemispheres, the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn, the Arctic and Antarctic Circle and the difference in time zones.
- Use maps, atlases and globes to locate countries and describe features studied.
