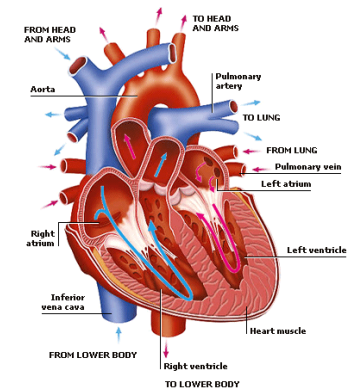
In Science we will be focussing on “Animals including humans. The circulatory system.”
