Narratives and Traditional Tales**

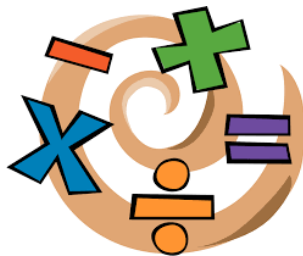
We will be writing based on 'The Journey' by Francesca Sanna,

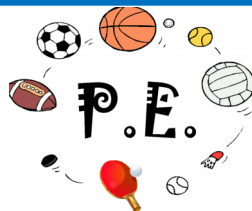


In maths, we will be revising for SATS in the first weeks of term, then studying:

- Statistics

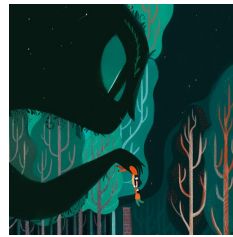


We will have PE on Tuesdays and Thursdays this half term. We will be enjoying athletics and fitness, and netball.
